Star of the week

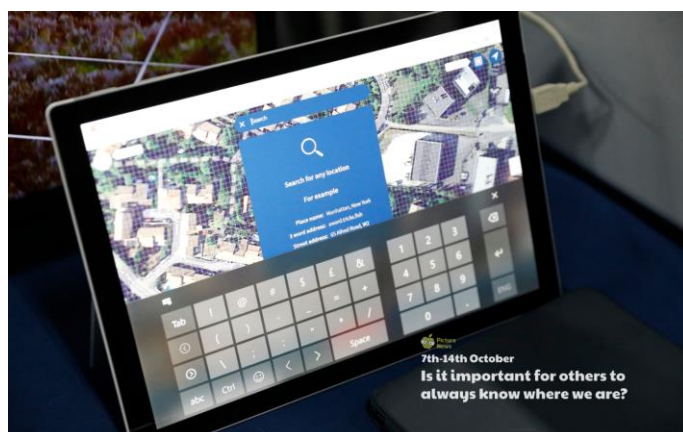
