Our new writing unit in Y5 is Instructions. For our Brilliant Beginning, we followed a set of instructions to create chocolate snowballs. It was a delicious lesson



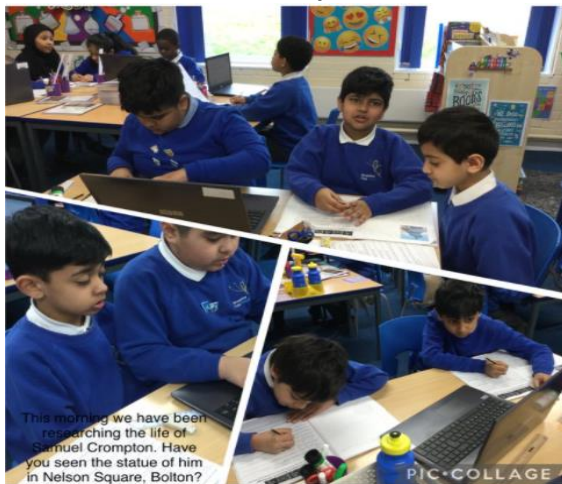

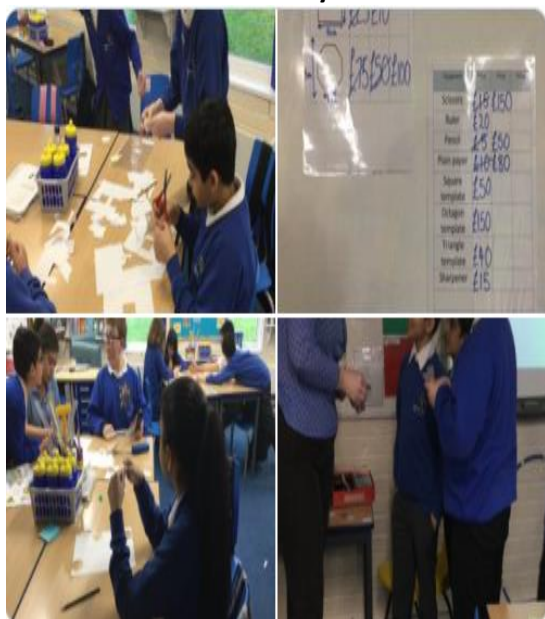
This morning we have been researching the life of Samuel Crompton. Have you seen the statue of him in Nelson Square, Bolton?

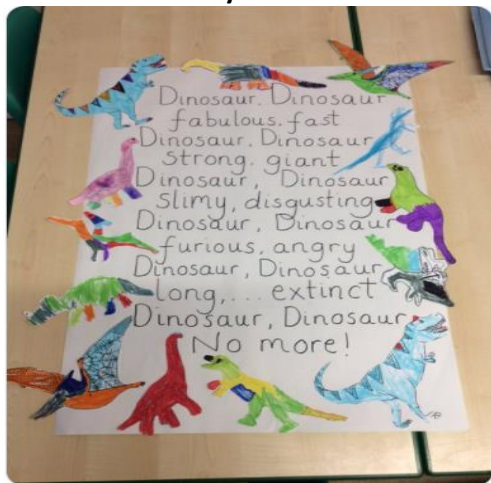

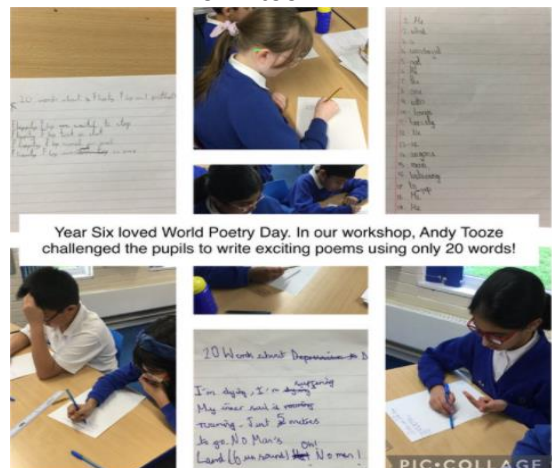
Year 3 had a brilliant time working with the poet Andy Tooze today. We were inspired by his fantastic poetry and enjoyed creating our own poems about animals.

Year One enjoyed their PE this morning, team work and problem solving 🤝



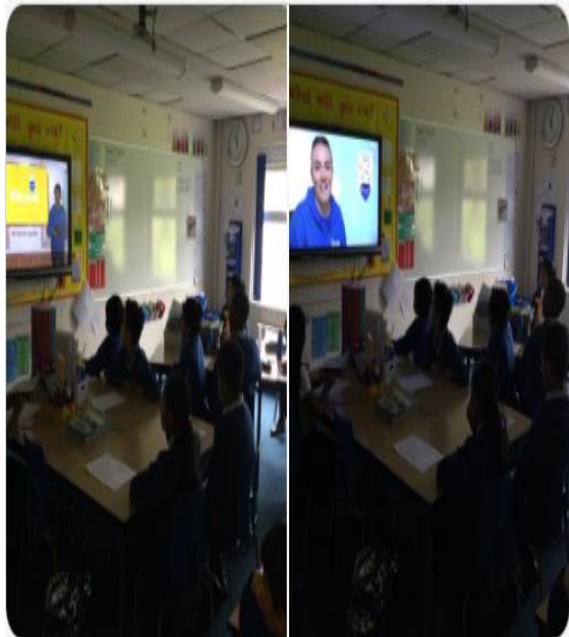
Nursery and Reception have brought in their egg entries today. Wow! They are so creative! We went to the school hall this morning to visit everyone else's creations. Well done everyone!

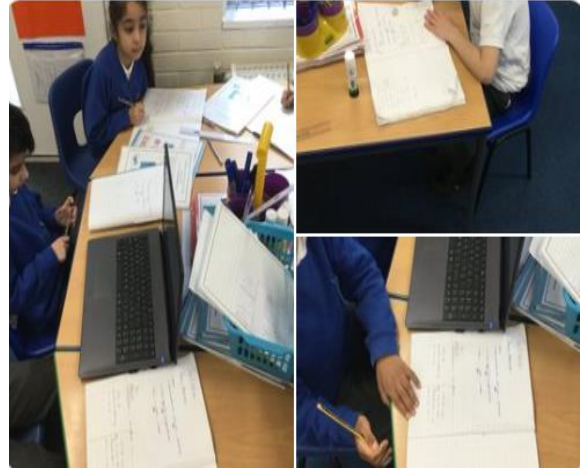

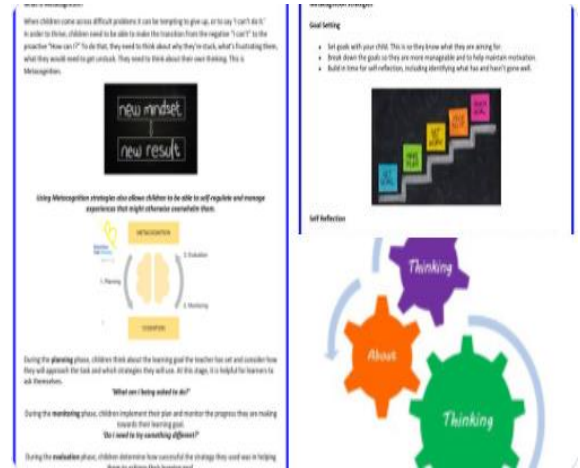

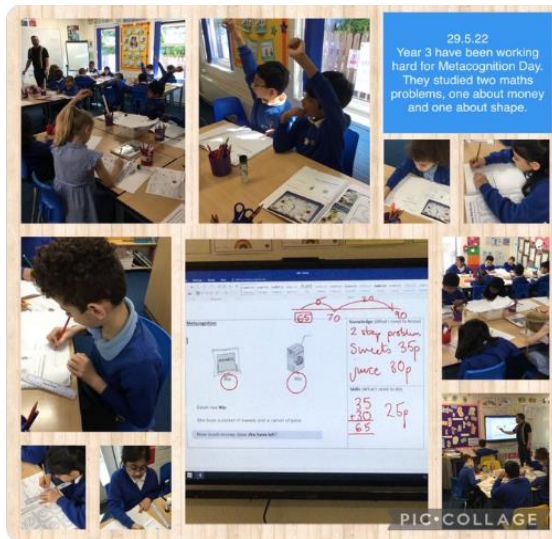
Year One have really enjoyed using the puppets to retell After the Storm by Nick Butterworth and then using the story talk to help further develop their writing skills

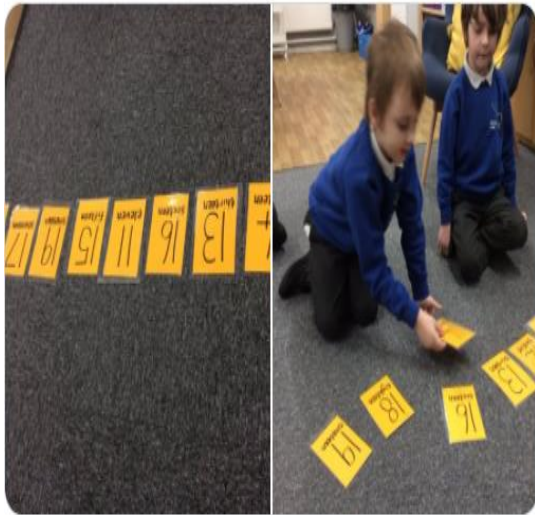

As part of our Design Technology lesson Year One are experimenting and exploring different types of construction



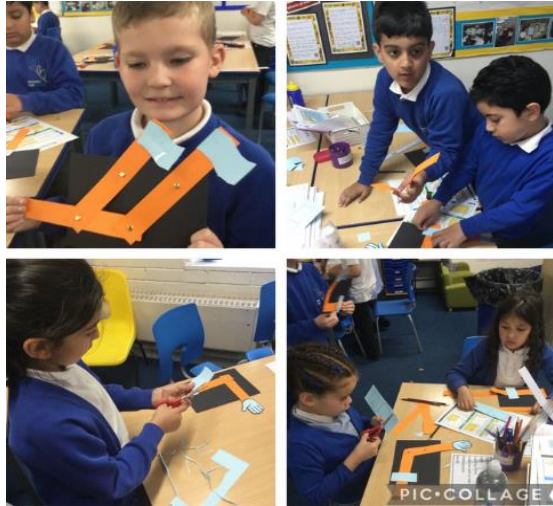
Year One using look, cover, write, check for our spelling challenge this morning

Year 5 have enjoyed taking part in lots of well-being activities this morning including a sharing circle, yoga, meditation and mindfulness colouring



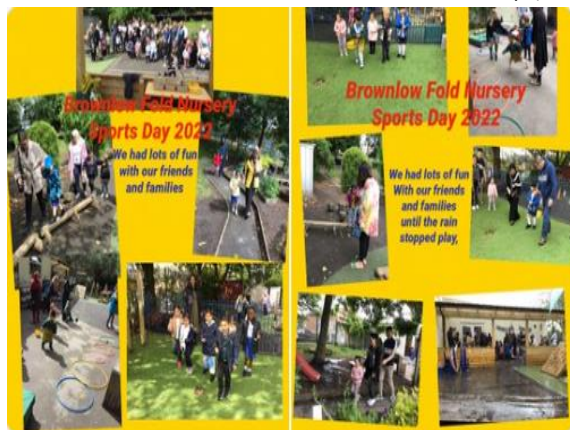
Year 3 loved gardening, painting bird feeders and creating their own plant pots for our outdoor environment day

Nursery have had some visitors over the past few weeks, today they released them into the wild. 🦋



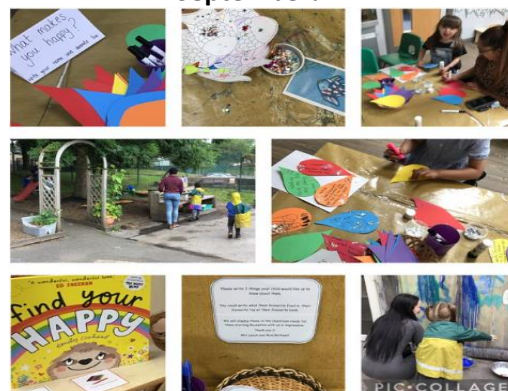
Receptions class assembly was ROARSOME! Thank you to all our families for coming to watch and celebrate our learning with us!
