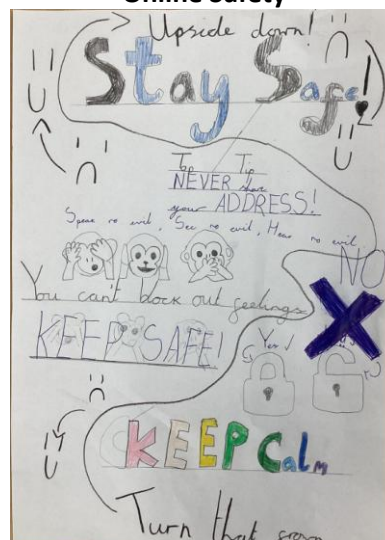

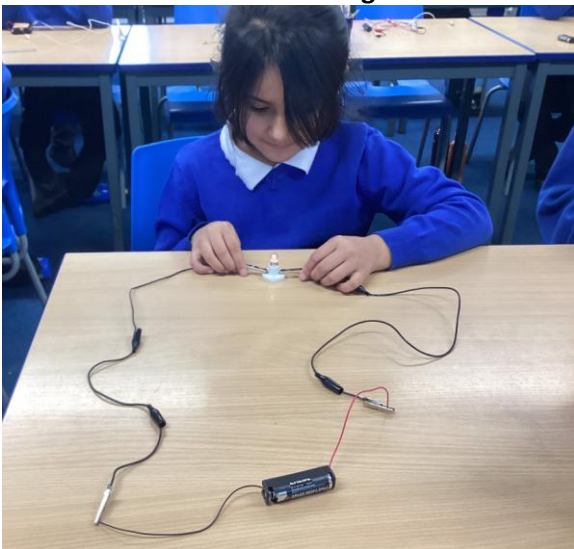

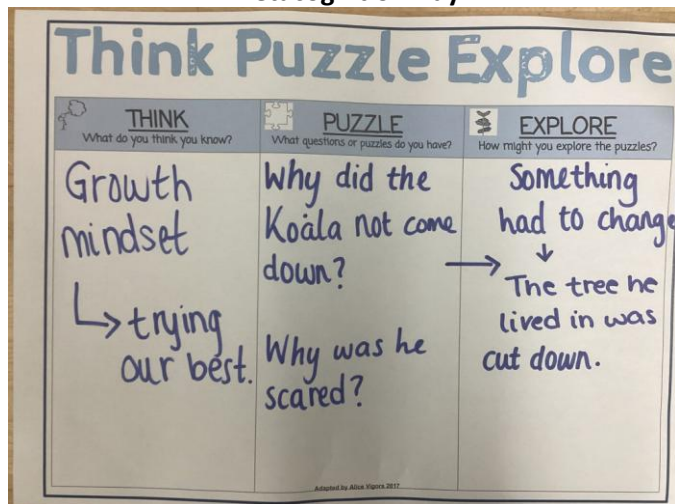

Year 4 loved their Commando Joe session this week. They worked in teams to build dens!



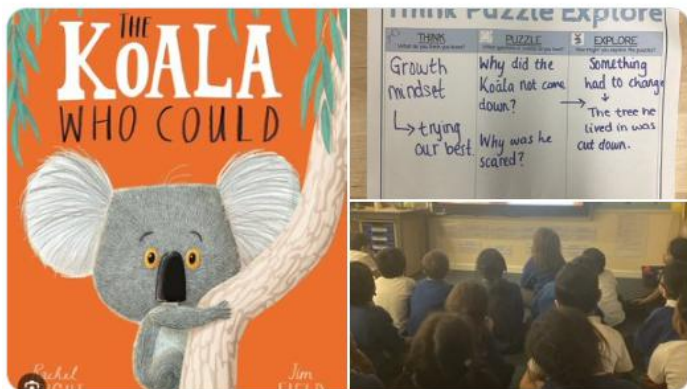

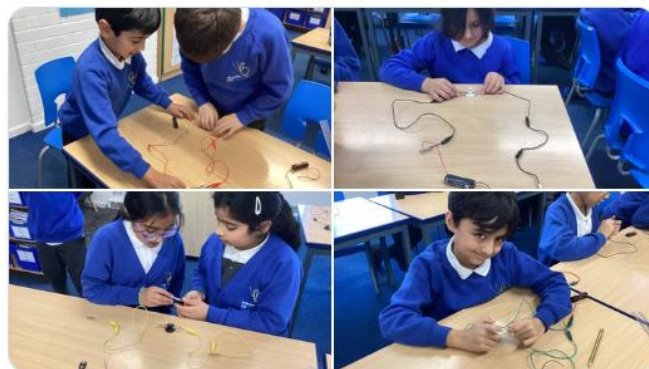

This afternoon some of the Year 4 pupils chose to complete their writing on an iPad. They wrote non chronological reports about Japan. This links to their Geography unit of work.



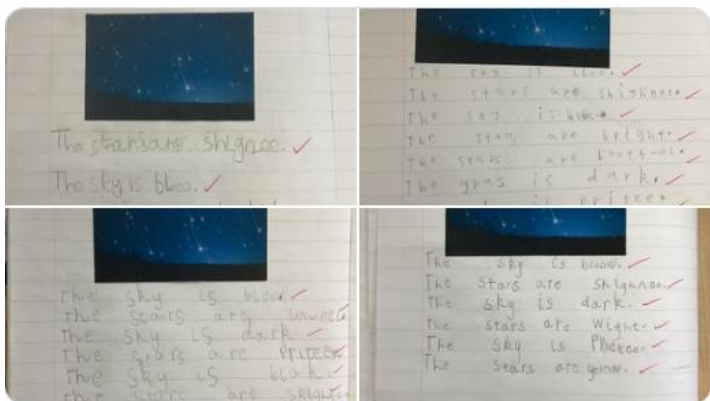

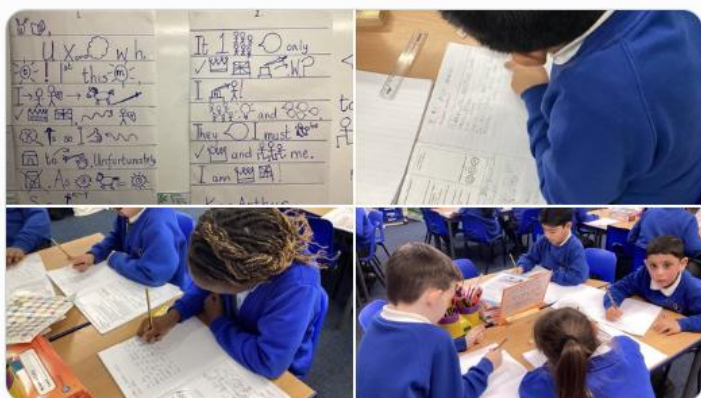
Year Three have been applying their scientific knowledge and vocabulary in our investigation this morning

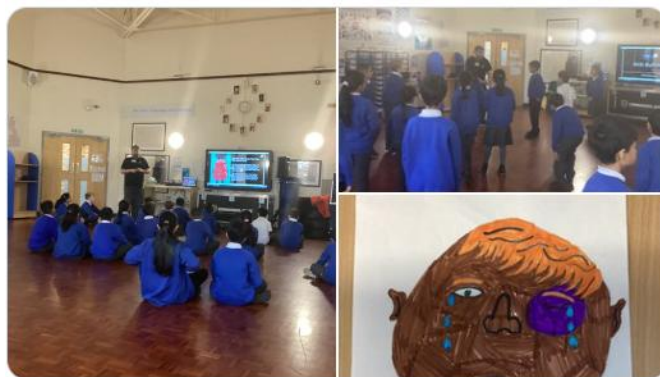
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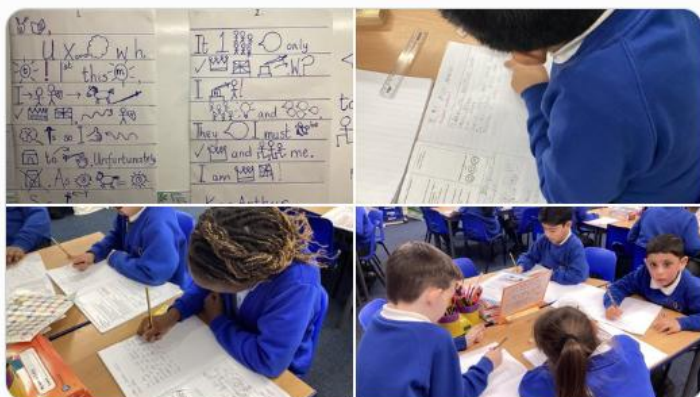

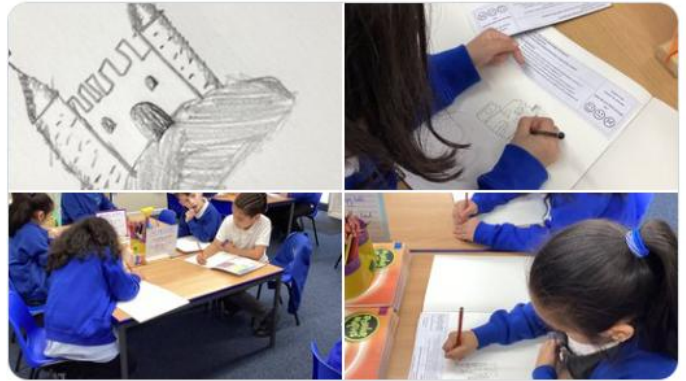

Year 5 showed excellent reflection skills during today's activity to celebrate Growth Mindset day. We know that a positive attitude and a growth mindset are vital for success!



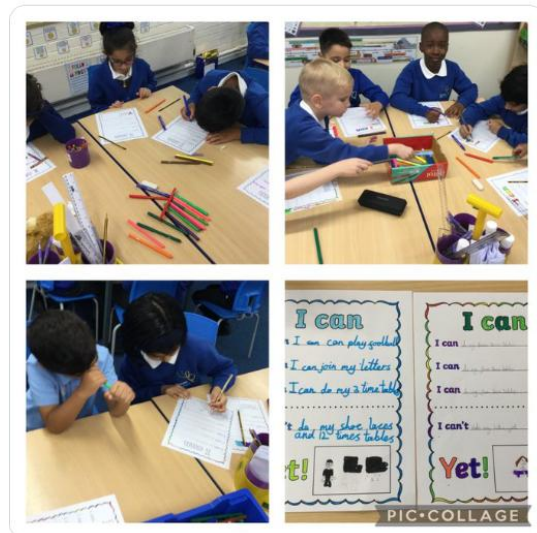

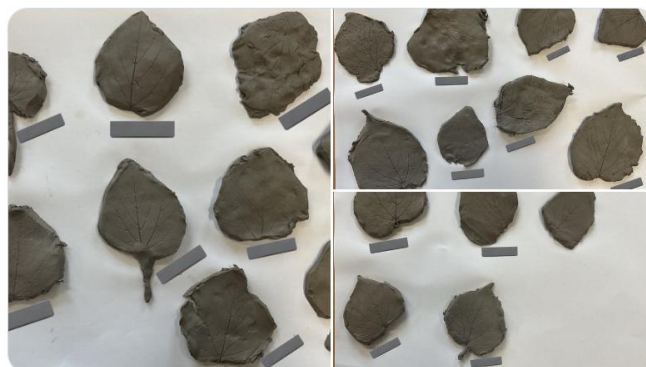
