



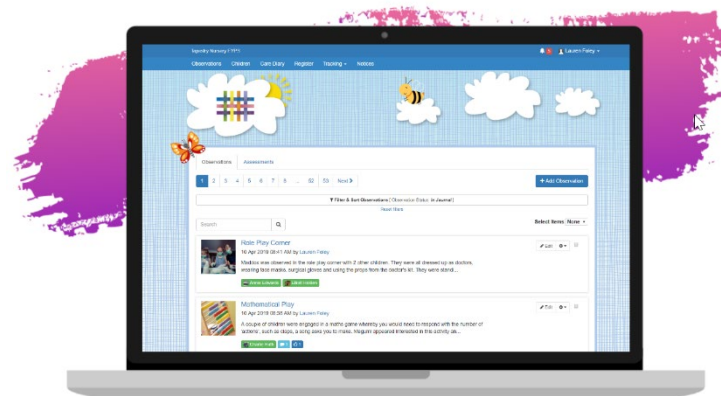

Tapestry Parent Guide



What is Tapestry?

- Tapestry is on line learning journal for every child in Nursery and Reception.
- Nursery and Reception teachers observe the children in their play, take photographs or videos and comment on what the child is learning.
- Teachers link the observations to the Early Years Curriculum and the Characteristics of Effective Learning.
- It can be accessed via the internet and through the website, or downloaded as an app.



How you can use it at home...

- We would love for you to comment on your children's learning journey, you will receive regular updates on your child's experiences in school.
- It would be fantastic if you could add your own observations of your child when you notice them doing wonderful things at home.
- Tapestry can be used on iPhone, Androids, IOS phones, laptops and computers.



Safe Usage

No information from Tapestry can be shared with other people, or published in any way.

- Photographs or videos cannot be posted on social media or displayed in public places.
- Misuse of Tapestry will result in withdrawal of your account.

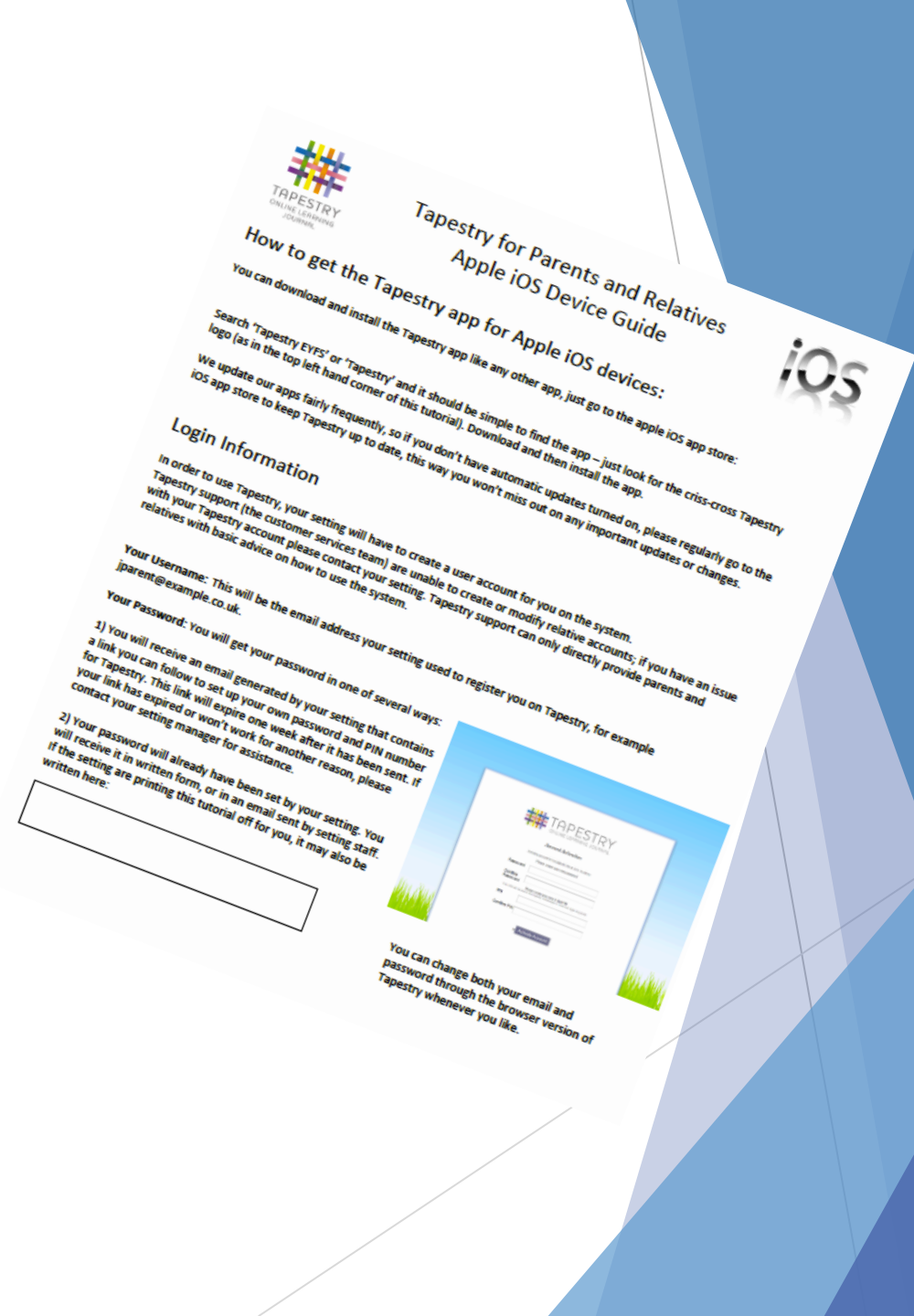

How do I add comments?

Every time you go onto an observation there is an option to add a comment on the bottom (a lot like Facebook).

To add an observation simply click onto 'add observation'. There are leaflets available here to support you if you are using an IOS phone, android or the Web - please help yourself.

Tell us if they have been doing anything similar at home or mentioned their learning.

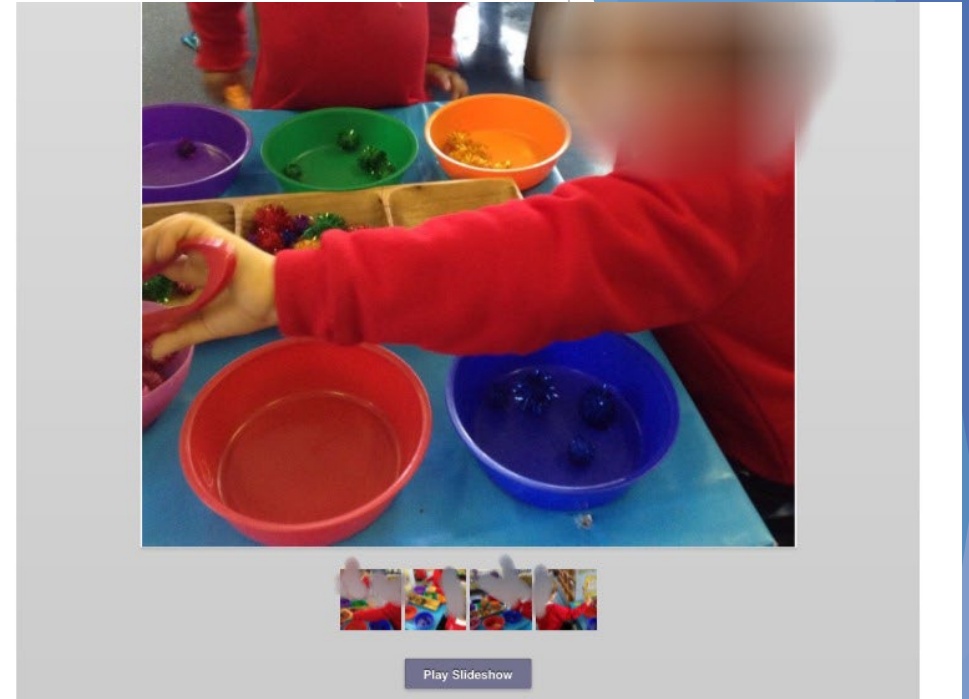
Tell us how proud you are of their achievements.

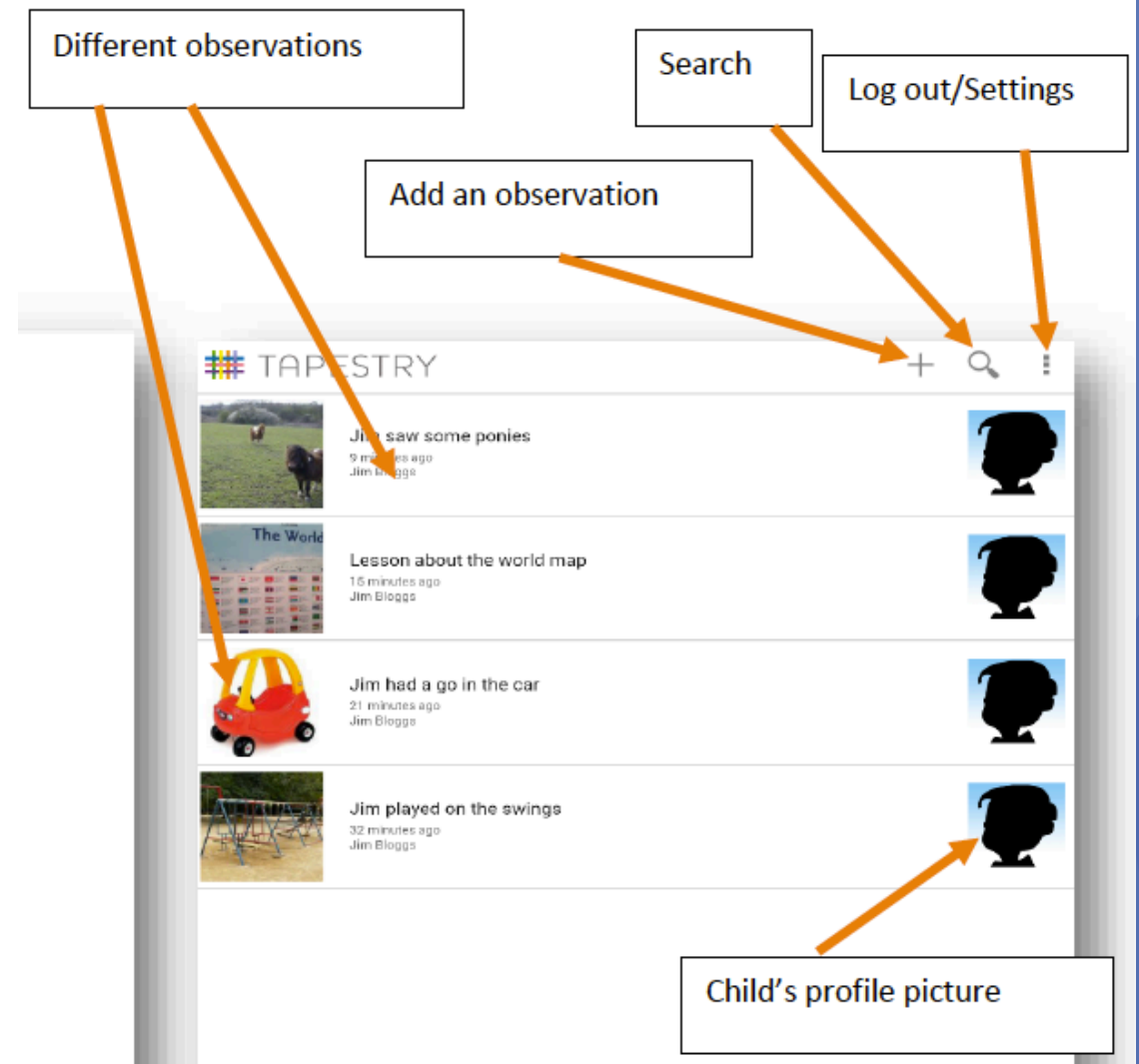
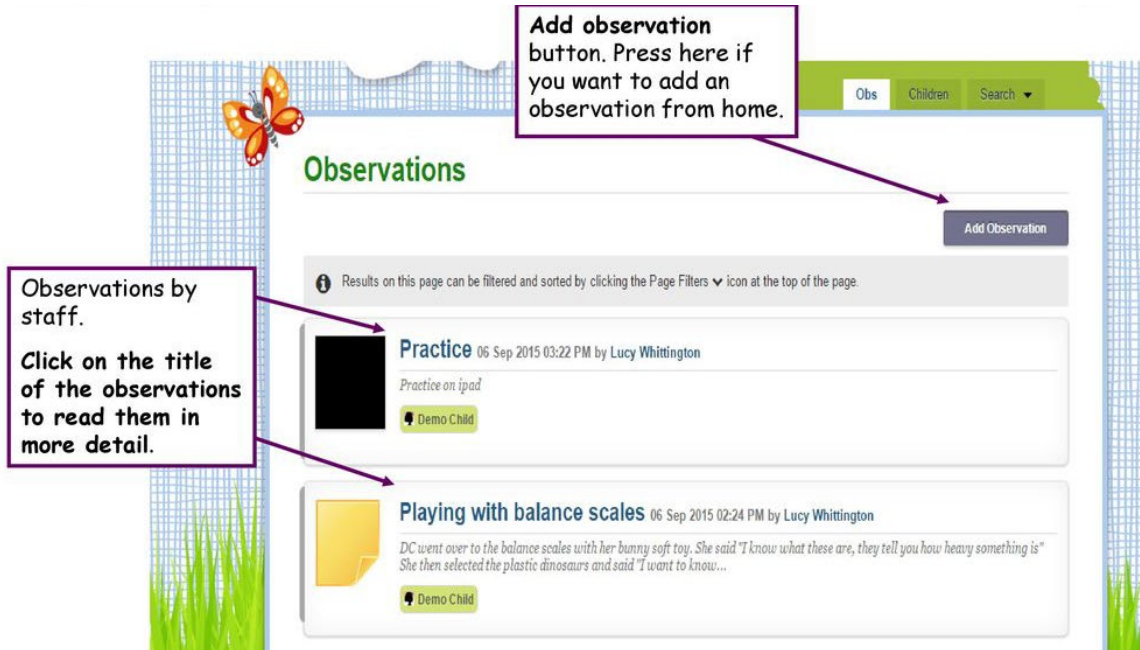

How do I add an observation from home?

Adding an observation can look different depending how you are accessing Tapestry.
(Website or app).

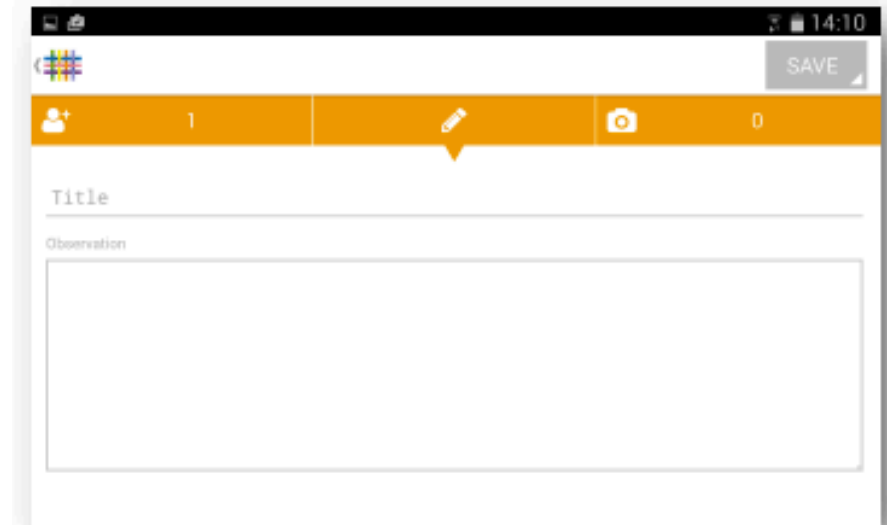
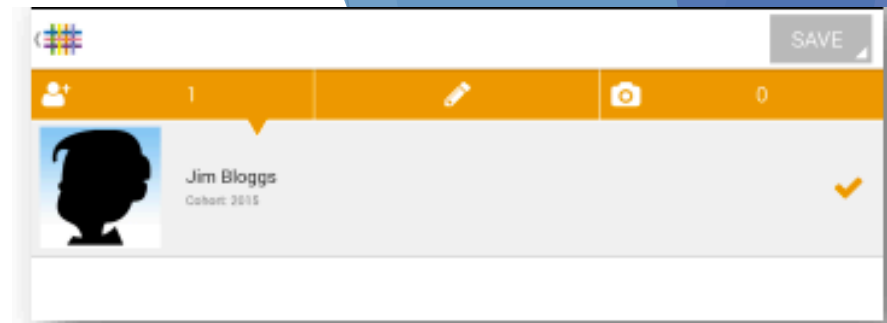


How do I add an observation from home?

- ▶ First select the child you are adding an observation for.

(You will only be able to choose from the children who are linked to your account)

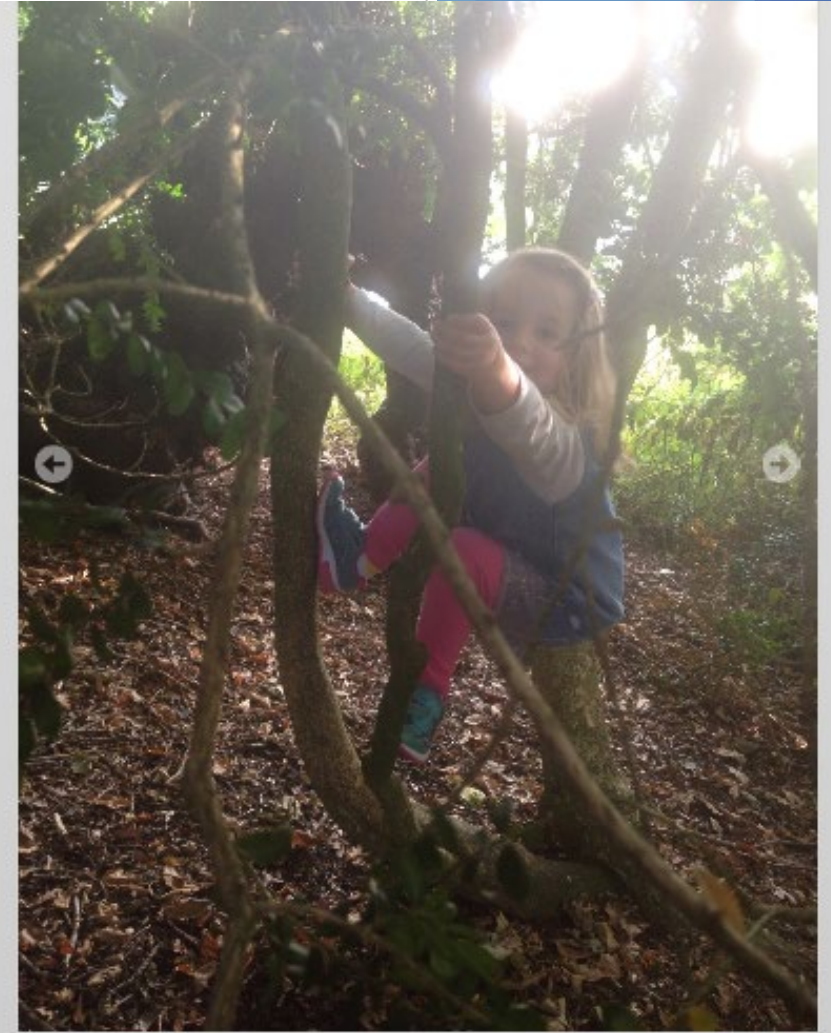
- ▶ Press the pencil icon to write the notes for your observation.
 - ▶ Give your observation a title.
- ▶ To add a photo or video press the camera icon, you can take a photo through the app.
- ▶ If you have already taken a photo and it is saved in your photo library then choose to 'choose from library'
 - ▶ When you have finished press SAVE
- ▶ Your observation will now be saved in the child's journal.



What should I observe?

Experiences that you have shared together, things you have noticed your child doing independently.

- ▶ Achievements
 - ▶ Swimming
 - ▶ Gymnastics
 - ▶ writing
 - ▶ counting
 - ▶ colouring
 - ▶ Painting
- ▶ And much, much more!

Things to be aware of...

- ▶ You may not be able to view all your child's photos, sometimes if it is a group photo this can mean you will be unable to see it.
- ▶ Observations may not be added daily
- ▶ If you do not have access to the internet please speak with your child's teacher as they can support you with accessing their learning journal.



Main Message...

- *Make sure you've signed up*
- *Comment on observations from school*
- *Add your own observations*
- *Talk to your child about what you have seen on tapestry*
