

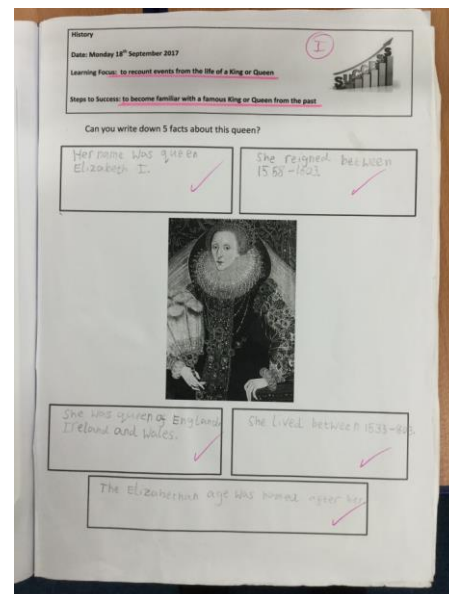
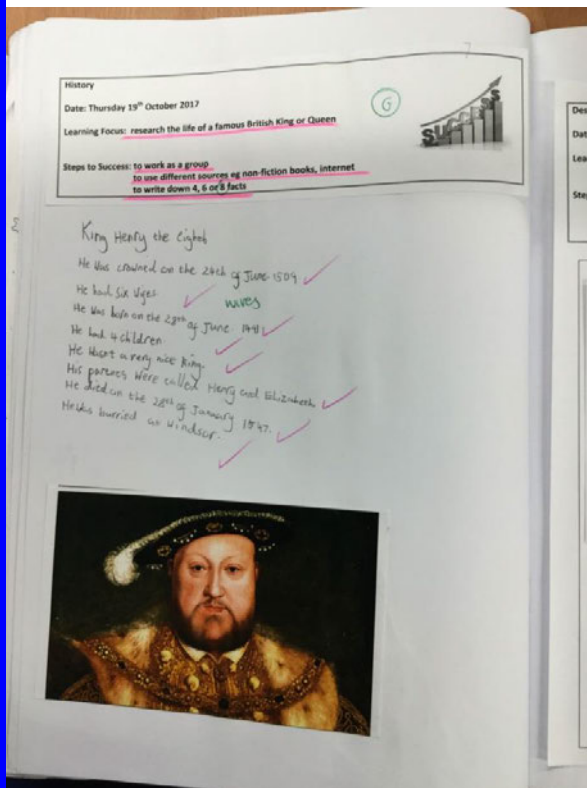
This is how we promote British Values in our Year Two Class at Brownlow Fold Primary School

The rule of law

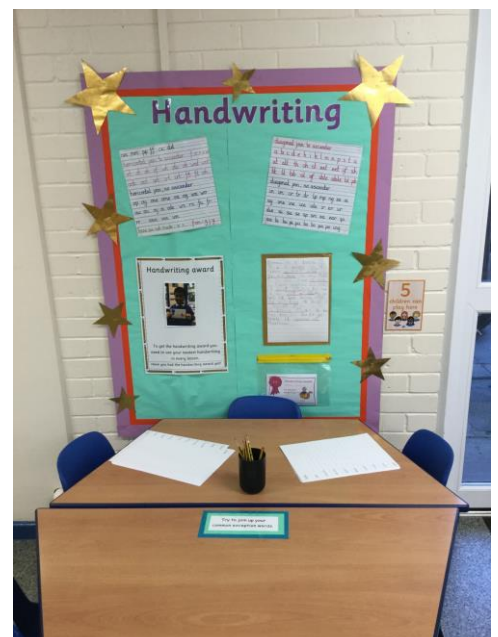
In the Year 2 classroom there is a display that the children regularly interact with to ensure that they are following the school rules. This display also reinforces the rewards and consequences if the school rules are not followed. Here is a photograph of our behaviour display.



In Year 2 we promote positive learning and behaviour in our classroom environment. We do this through discussing what positive learning looks like. Our growth mind set display which is in our classroom is referred to by both children and adults during lessons and daily school life. Here is a photograph of our growth mind set display.



In Year 2 we promote positive learning by having our own class rewards. We have a 'reader of the week' reward. This is where children have to read every night at home and get their record signed. This promotes the positive learning of reading and the children enjoy receiving this reward. When a child is chosen for this reward they get their photo displayed on the display and they get to take a certificate home. We also have a handwriting reward. This reward is received by a child if they have worked on their handwriting in every lesson for the week. If a child receives this reward then their picture and handwriting is displayed on the display board and they get to take a certificate home. Individual liberty

During snack time in Year 2 the children are encouraged to share any news they have about home life. This news can range from something exciting happening at home to something they have brought to school to show and share.
